

What commercial content will LGfL consider?

- LGfL's intention and practice is to purchase licences in perpetuity. (LGfL does *not* fund subscription based software)
- Content must be online and hosted on LGfL servers
- Content must provide a solution to an identified gap in current LGfL content provision
- Content must be of high quality (pedagogically and technically)

- In licensing for all state maintained schools within the region, LGfL seeks a 90%+ discount on content purchases, when compared to the nominal total revenue generated by equivalent sales to all maintained schools.

Further information to be noted:

- Video clips integrated into content ideally need to have embed codes available for London teachers to integrate the material into their preferred learning platform.
- LGfL is not currently a member of the emergent UK access Management Federation. Content hosted on LGfL servers will be subject to the LGfL Access Management Federation established in 2005.
