

Guidance for online content providers requesting links from the LGfL website.

Many organisations contact LGfL to request links to their online resources.

Before this can occur the resources will be subject to the LGfL editorial process.

In the first instance, this evaluation will be undertaken by the LGfL Content Manager and may then be subject to further evaluation by the LGfL Editorial Board.

There are multiple requests for this type of linking every week, so the response time will vary - but is usually weeks, rather than days.

The following information should be supplied to aid the evaluation of the resource:

1. If the website / organisation collects user data, are all staff that can access this data CRB registered?
2. Is the company / organisation registered at companies house?
3. Explanation of how by linking to the external site - it enhances the existing LGfL content portfolio? E.g. what gap does the resource fill?
4. Evidence of London teachers use and impact on standards of attainment
5. Evidence of endorsements from London Schools and LA's
6. Description of age range, subject area and aspect of the Curriculum the resources support.

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
