

# Terms and Conditions of Use for LGfL Services and Resources

Access to and use of LGfL Services and Resources (hereinafter 'LGSR') is provided by **the London Grid for Learning Trust** (hereinafter **LGfL**) subject to the following terms:

1. By using **LGSR** you agree to be legally bound by these terms, which shall take effect immediately on your first use of **LGSR**. If you do not agree to be legally bound by all the following terms please do not access and/or use **LGSR**.
2. **The LGfL** may change these terms at any time by posting changes online. Please review these terms regularly to ensure you are aware of any changes made. Your continued use of **LGSR** after changes are posted means you agree to be legally bound by these terms as updated and/or amended.

## Use of LGSR

3. You may not copy, reproduce, republish, download, post, broadcast, transmit or otherwise use **LGSR** content in any way except for educational and non-commercial use. You also agree not to adapt, alter or create a derivative work from any **LGSR** content except for your educational and non-commercial use. Any other use of **LGSR** content requires the prior written permission of **the LGfL**.
4. You agree to use **LGSR** only for lawful purposes, and in a way that does not infringe the rights of, restrict or inhibit anyone else's use and enjoyment of **LGSR**. Prohibited behaviour includes harassing or causing distress or inconvenience to any person, transmitting obscene or offensive content or disrupting the normal flow of dialogue or information within **LGSR**.

5. **LGSR** content, including the information, names, images, pictures, logos and icons regarding or relating to **the LGfL** or its services, is provided "AS IS" and on an "IS AVAILABLE" basis without any representations or any kind of warranty made (whether express or implied by law), including the implied warranties of satisfactory quality, fitness for a particular purpose, non-infringement, compatibility, security and accuracy.
6. **The LGfL** will not be liable for any damages, including indirect or consequential damages, or any damages arising from use or loss of use, data or profits, whether in contract, negligence or other tortious action, arising from or in connection with the use of **LGSR**.

### **If you breach these Terms of Use**

9. If you fail to abide by these terms you will be formally warned and may subsequently have services withdrawn.
10. If you post or send offensive or inappropriate content anywhere on or to **LGSR** and **the LGfL** considers such behaviour to be serious and/or repeated, **the LGfL** may use whatever information that is available to it about you to stop any further such infringements. This can include informing relevant third parties.

### General

11. If there is any conflict between these terms and specific terms appearing elsewhere on **LGSR** (including local house rules) then the latter shall prevail.

If any of these terms are determined to be illegal, invalid or otherwise unenforceable by reason of the laws of any state or country in which these terms are intended to be effective, then to the extent and within the jurisdiction in which that term is illegal, invalid or unenforceable, it shall be severed and deleted from these terms and the remaining terms shall survive, remain in full force and effect and continue to be binding and enforceable.
13. These terms shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
